



## **Webinar 9: Australian Curriculum V9 Update | The Arts Jane Polley, ACARA**

Jane Polley, Curriculum Specialist, The Arts, Australian Curriculum, Assessment, and Reporting Authority (ACARA) is responsible for the Australian Curriculum: The Arts learning area. Prior to this role Jane was the Curriculum Lead, The Arts for the Tasmanian Department for Education, Children, and Young People (DECYP) where she developed and wrote senior secondary courses across all five art subjects. She also led or facilitated projects including art-in-education residencies (with Arts Tas), STEAM symposia, teacher conferences, digital arts resources, and industry collaborations. During her career Jane was a senior drama and dance teacher, TCE examiner, director of a School of Performing Arts, university tutor (UTAS), actor, deviser, and voice over artist. She was a council member for the National Advocates for Arts Education (NAAE), board member of Drama Australia, and chair of the Tasmanian Theatre Company. She has a B.Ed. (Secondary, Drama/Dance), M.Ed. (Drama) with Honours, and her current PhD research is an inquiry into the political and public discourse that will follow the publication of the 2022 PISA creative expression results.
