### **Mark Lamont**

Mark Lamont researches, disrupts, conceptualises, and works to implement curriculum reforms in the digital Age. Influenced by Dewey and Freire, his career began in Special Education in Sydney's west. Within a dozen years, Mr Lamont had led curriculum development at three of Sydney's new high schools as their inaugural HSC cohorts graduated. In 2000, Mr Lamont joined the executive team of Australia's first ISP for schools, leading efforts to deliver the first Managed Internet Service to thousands of Australian schools and millions of students abroad, offering curriculum-aligned online resources and learning tools to half of Australia's schools.

### **Stephen Shapiro**

In 2000 my graduate school thesis turned into a parabolic-growth company titled "SchoolFusion." I've continued this success through leveraging my 25 years of school-to home communications by inventing SchoolFeed.org. SchoolFeed combines multiple data feeds such as WhatsApp and Google Classroom to provide a hands-free (and free) teacher communication solution. Most importantly, I've been fortunate to surround myself with a team of people whom I consider wonderfully talented and noble in their pursuits.
