Judy Halbert and Linda Kaser are co-leaders of the Networks of Inquiry and Indigenous Education. They are faculty members at the University of British Columbia where they lead the Transformative Educational Leadership Program for system level leaders. They are committed to achieving equity and quality for all learners—and to networking for innovation and improvement across systems. In doing so they draw on their experience as teachers, principals, district level leaders and senior policy advisors at the Ministry of Education.

Judy and Linda were identified by the Big Change Organization as pioneers for their work with inquiry networks. In 2019, NOIIE was awarded the prestigious Cmolik Prize for the enhancement of public education in British Columbia and the network currently includes schools in ten international jurisdictions.
